ASSOCIATE DEGREE

The Associate in Applied Science Degree in Aviation Technology provides students with a general undergraduate education with a foundation in aviation.

Students qualify for a wide variety of careers in the Aviation/Aerospace industry, or for those students who are employed in an aviation-related area; this degree will provide the knowledge and college credentials needed to be competitive for advancement or promotion. The AASD Program is 24 months long.

FINANCIAL AID

State and Federal Programs are available to help students finance their education. NCI participates in the Pell Grant, William D. Ford Federal Direct Loan Program, and Parent Plus Loan Program, along with Tennessee State Programs (TSAC). Those eligible may also use their Veterans Educational Benefits towards financing the program.
